You are most welcome. We hope that you will be refreshed and encouraged by our worship today.

If you are new to traditional and liturgical worship (that is, if everything looks very, very foreign at this service) please feel free to just sit and watch. You need feel no pressure to participate. It usually takes some weeks to become familiar and comfortable with the liturgy.

If you are a baptized member of Christ's Church and a communicant member in another branch of Christ's Church, you are welcome to partake of the Holy Communion. If you have any doubts or reservations regarding participating in the sacrament, please refrain from participating and talk to the priest after the service.

Order of Service

The service of Holy Communion is found in the 1928 Book of Common Prayer available at the back of the sanctuary. The service begins on page 67. Please listen to the celebrant (the priest conducting the service) for the appropriate page numbers.

Persecution in Indonesia

When local Muslims in the Bekasi City area noticed that some Christians were using an empty building for a worship service on Jan. 23, they gathered at the building to protest the meeting. Members of the Pillar Asih Protestant Church eventually came to an agreement with the local residents and signed a statement, witnessed by police, promising not to conduct Christian activities at the location. Although Christianity is legal in Indonesia, a majority of neighbors must agree to the presence of a church in an area before one can be built, and Islamists frequently stir up opposition to churches in Muslim neighborhoods. Pray that members of the Pillar Asih Protestant Church will find a suitable place to worship.

Indonesia is the most populous Muslim country in the world, composing 13 percent of the world's Muslim population. While most Indonesian Muslims practice an animistic version known as "folk" Islam, proponents of radical Islamic ideology have encouraged and engaged in violence against Christians.
